




A lesson in Humility

As the sunset, the Goju Ryu Shimbukai Dojo stood quiet, but the day's lesson continued to resonate within its walls.






Back at home, the students reflected on their day, each finding personal meaning in Sensei words.

Parents noticed a change in their character, one filled with more respect and thoughtfulness.






Kimsour Sensei, too
